Notes and Criteria regarding the Youth Development Awards 2017

- 1 Any young rower aged 13 to 20 years at 31st December this year, and registered with Rowing NSW, is eligible to apply.
- 2 If the application is completed by hand please print.
- 3 A minimum of four awards will be presented this year with a least one from each gender.
- 4 The closing date for applications is Friday 5th May 2017 at 5:00 pm.
- 5 Applications may be sent by mail to the Hon. Secretary, NSW Union of Rowers Inc. P O. Box 208, FIVE DOCK 2046 or by email to secretary@nswrowers.com
If emailing your application please send the signed original application form in the mail.

PLEASE DO NOT SUBMIT YOUR APPLICATION TO ROWING NSW.
- 6 The Awards are for a minimum of ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS each and shall be used in the incoming season for regatta expenses, training expenses or towards the purchase of equipment.
- 7 The Awards will be presented at a venue to be advised.
- 8 The Awards will be determined by the Executive of the Union of Rowers following a report from their Evaluation Committee.
- 9 Each recipient shall submit a written report on how the award was used and the benefits of receiving the award.
IT IS A REQUIREMENT THAT RECIPIENTS CONTINUE ROWING COMPETITIVELY DURING THE NEXT SEASON.
- 10 Consideration will be given not only to performance but also to the funding needs of the young rowers applying, and in some circumstances an increase in the value of the award may be forthcoming. Country based athletes are urged to apply.
Rowers with a disability or from disadvantaged communities are also encouraged to apply.
- 11 Emphasis will be placed on developing rowers.
- 12 Applicants must have rowed for a period exceeding six months.
- 13 Rowers who have previously been awarded a Union of Rowers Scholarship are not eligible to apply again.
- 14 All applicants can rest assured that all details in the applications will be kept confidential.

All applications must be lodged on these forms and must be verified and duly endorsed by your club president, club captain, or school rowing master.
